Development of a global strategy on fisheries and aquaculture statistics.

More analysis on import notification data;

Provide guidance to the industry on food hazards.


The need to for enhanced collaboration with CITES and IUCN.

Development of the database only with non-traditional trade issues;

Further assess to include tariff and non-tariff measures.

MANOUTCOMES OF THE SESSION (2/2)





Collect information on trade agreements, indicating which contain non-traditional trade clauses.

Strength efforts and promote the FAO Voluntary Code of Conduct for Food Loss and Waste(FLW)
Reduction;

Creation of the FAO technical guidelines addressing causes and remedies of FLW.

Support for the development of the FAO Guidance;

Speed up the planned work for an endorsement by FAO Members.
